



Recreation & Parks Rec Partner Pass Registration

Section 1: Rec Partner Pass Overview

The **Rec Partner Pass** provides free admission to support persons accompanying a participant with a disability in Recreation & Parks registered programs, drop-in programs, and Seniors Centres.

Individuals with a permanent disability or temporary disability requiring assistance to participate in Recreation & Parks Department programs are eligible for the **Rec Partner Pass**.

A **Rec Partner** is an individual who:

- Accompanies a participant with a disability to provide one-on-one assistance that is not provided by program instructors.
- Supports the participant with a disability in program participation.
- Provides full supervision throughout the entire program.
- Behaves in a manner that supports a positive program experience for all program participants.
- For aquatic activities, is comfortable, and behaves safely, in the water.

The Pass is help by the individual with a disability, or the legal guardian of the individual with a disability, and is responsible for following the terms of use of the Pass:

TERMS of USE:

1. A **Rec Partner Pass** Form is completed and submitted by the person with the disability or a legal guardian on his or her behalf.
2. The Pass is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of issue after which a re-registration is required.
3. The person with a disability presents the Pass each time he or she attends the activity with his/her Rec Partner.
4. The person with a disability and the Rec Partner enter, attend, and exit the activity together.
5. The Rec Partner behaves in a manner that supports a positive program experience for all program participants.
6. The applicant is responsible for ensuring the Rec Partner is aware of the Terms of Use.
7. For Fitness Classes, the Rec Partner completes a PAR-Q and provides the instructor with a contact telephone number for emergency purposes.
8. Fees associated with meals and trips at the Seniors Centres cannot be waived.
9. These terms of use are subject to change without notice by the Town of Halton Hills.
