Greenwood & Fairview Cemetery Monument Repairs

HALTON HILLS, ON – Restoration work on cemetery monuments in Georgetown’s Greenwood Cemetery and the Fairview Cemetery in Acton will occur through October and November as part of the Town’s ongoing cemetery care and maintenance. The repairs include dis-assembling large cemetery monuments that are leaning and pose safety concerns, pouring new concrete foundations for the monuments and re-installing the monument on the new foundation.

“The preservation and upkeep of our cemeteries is important not just from a safety perspective but also out of respect to those who have passed before us,” said Mayor Rick Bonnette.

The first phase of work, (professionally dis-assembling and lowering the leaning monument sections) took place in fall 2016. The remaining work will take place this fall and includes excavating and pouring new proper concrete foundations and professional re-assembly of the monuments so they are vertical, stable and safe. Completion of this project is anticipated by early 2018.

About the Town of Halton Hills

The Town of Halton Hills, with a population of approximately 60,000, consists of two urban centres, Georgetown and Acton, with three hamlets – Glen Williams, Stewarttown and Norval – and several smaller settlements. Halton Hills has long been recognized for its natural beauty, active agricultural community, high quality of life and proximity to major centres, including Brampton, Mississauga and Toronto. The Town is ranked as one of the top small communities in Canada by a national magazine.
