



### **BY-LAW NO. 2010-0070**

A By-law to regulate the operation of Motorized Snow Vehicles within the Town of Halton Hills including any highways therein or any part or parts thereof and to repeal By-law 75-82

**WHEREAS** subsection 7(2) of the *Motorized Snow Vehicle Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c. M. 44 provides that the Council of a municipality may pass by-laws regulating, governing or prohibiting the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality including any highway or any part or parts thereof;

**AND WHEREAS** subsection 11(3) of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O.2001, Chapter 25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to pass by-laws for traffic on highways under the jurisdiction of the Town;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF HALTON HILLS ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

#### **SHORT TITLE**

The short title of this By-law is the *Motorized Snow Vehicles By-law*.

1. In this By-law:

**Council** means the Council for the Town;

**Highway** means a common and public highway and includes a street, bridge or other structure forming part of a Highway over or across which a Highway passes, and includes the whole of a road allowance under the jurisdiction of the Town;

**Motorized Snow Vehicle** means a self propelled vehicle designed to be driven primarily on snow;

**Person** includes a company, a corporation, a partnership, or an individual person, and the singular shall include the plural; and

**Town** means The Corporation of the Town of Halton Hills, or the geographic area comprising the Town of Halton Hills.

2. No Person shall operate a Motorized Snow Vehicle along any Highway or part of any Highway within the Town of Halton Hills, except for the purpose of crossing a Highway at a 90 degree angle to the direction of the Highway.
3. Exceptions to this By-law for an organized event may be permitted by Council.
4. Any Person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act*.

5. A Police Officer is hereby vested with the authority of administering and enforcing the provisions of the By-law.
6. If a court of competent jurisdiction should declare any section or a part of this By-law to be invalid, the remainder of this By-law shall continue in force unless the court makes an order to the contrary.
7. That Town of Halton Hills By-law No.75-82 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
8. This By-law shall come into full force and effect on its date of passing.
