Things to remember

When boarding the taxi, be prepared to present your youth registration card to the driver. Taxi Scrip is for the personal use of registered passengers only.

Coupons cannot be sold or resold to another registered user or any other person. Abuse of this policy will result in dismissal from the program. Taxi Scrip service is for travel within the municipal boundaries of Halton Hills only. Drivers are not permitted to accept Taxi Scrip coupons as tip money.

What is the Taxi Scrip Program?

The Taxi Scrip program is an economically priced, curb-to-curb transportation program provided by the Town of Halton Hills for registered ActiVan riders. The program allows registered users the ability to make spontaneous travel decisions.

The Taxi Scrip program also allows ActiVan users to book a trip directly with local taxi companies at a 40% discount.

Note, E-Z Taxi and G'Town Taxi both have accessible vehicles that accommodate wheelchairs and scooters.

In order to purchase Taxi Scrip coupons, you must be a registered user. For information on how to apply call **905-702-6435** or visit haltonhills.ca/transit.

How do I use the Taxi Scrip Program?

- » Call a local taxi company
- » Show the taxi driver your Youth Taxi Scrip registration card
- » Use Taxi Scrip coupons to pay the fare on the meter
- » If the meter fare is over 60 cents, you must pay the extra amount. If the meter fare is under 60 cents, you do not have to pay the extra amount.



How do I pay for the taxi?

Each Taxi Scrip book has a value of \$20 and contain 20—\$1 taxi coupons. Taxis Scrip books are sold to registered users for \$12 at select retail locations. Each registrant is entitled to purchase a maximum of four Youth Taxi Scrip coupon books per month for a total value of \$80.

Subsidized Passes for low income users (SPLIT PASS)

The SPLIT Pass program subsidizes the cost of monthly taxi scrip coupons for low income registered users in Halton Hills. SPLIT passes are available for anyone who qualifies; including individuals who receive assistance from Ontario Works or Ontario Disability Support Program and sponsored refugees.

When applying through Halton Region you will be asked for:

- » Your most recent Notice of Assessment
- » Photo ID
- » Your Youth Taxi registration card

Once approved you may purchase 4 booklets of youth taxi scrip at a 50 % discount, once per month.
