IMPORTANT UPDATE

Habitat for Humanity Halton-Mississauga in partnership with the Town of Halton Hills would like to update you on the redevelopment progress of the property located at 37 King Street in Georgetown.

Beginning the week of November 11, 2019 (weather dependent), we will begin the process of deconstruction on the existing structure. Our subcontractors, Heritage Restoration Inc., will carefully dismantle the building, ensuring the preservation of the interior structural timbers for use in the final redesign. All work will be supervised by our heritage engineers at Facet Group Inc.

To ensure our work is not disruptive to the neighbourhood, our subcontractors will make every effort to leave GO Station traffic undisturbed during key commuter hours. After the building and existing foundation is removed from the site, the land will be graded and left to settle over the winter months while Habitat finalizes the required planning approvals and building plans with the Town of Halton Hills.

We look forward to sharing more details as they become available and finalized. We will be posting the latest updates on our website, habitathm.ca.
