Subject: Decision to give written approval of by-laws passed at the May 26, 2025 meeting of Council

Pursuant to the powers extended to the Head of Council under Sections 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, I, Ann Lawlor, Mayor for the Town of Halton Hills, hereby give written approval of the following by-laws passed at the Town of Halton Hills Council meeting held on May 26, 2025:

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0043 - A By-law to designate the McCuaig-Feller House, located at 2 King Street, Georgetown, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0044 - A By-law to designate the Moffit Forster House, located at 510 Main Street, Glen Williams, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0045 - A By-law to designate Pinegrove Cottage, located at 53 Charles Street, Georgetown, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0046 - A By-law to designate the Dufferin School, located at 10454 Regional Road 25, Speyside, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0047 - A By-law to designate the Gibraltar School, located at 11999 Fifth Line, Limehouse, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0048 - A By-law to amend the User Fee By-law 2024-0087 to add fees for Automated Speed Enforcement.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0049 - A By-law to amend Appendix A to User Fee By-law 2024-0087.

BY-LAW NO. 2025-0050 - A By-law to adopt the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on the 26th day of May, 2025 and to authorize its execution.
