**Subject:** **Decision to give written approval of by-laws passed at the November 17, 2025 meeting of Council**

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Pursuant to the powers extended to the Head of Council under Sections 284.11(4)(a)(i) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c.25, I, Ann Lawlor, Mayor for the Town of Halton Hills, hereby give written approval of the following by-laws passed at the Town of Halton Hills Council meeting held on November, 2025:

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0094** - A By-law to designate the Ainley House, located at 28 Mountain Street, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0095** - A By-law to designate the Norton House, located at 9 Prince Street under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0096** - A By-law to designate the McKinlay-McAllister House, located at 16 Main Street South under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0097** - A By-law to designate the Joseph Williams House, located at 511 Main Street, Glen Williams, under Part IV of the Ontario Heritage Act as being of cultural heritage value or interest.

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0098** - A By-law to Levy 2026 Interim Taxes and Establish Penalty and Interest Rates.

**BY-LAW NO. 2025-0099** - A By-law to adopt the proceedings of the Council Meeting held on the 17th day of November, 2025 and to authorize its execution.
