



Ultimate Neighbourhood Block Party Contest – Official Rules

Help support Halton Hills local food banks while competing for a chance to win an ULTIMATE neighbourhood block party experience hosted by the Hey Neighbour crew!

Eligibility

- The contest is open to legal residents of Halton Hills only.
- Registrants must be 18 years of age or older at the time of entry; however, all ages are allowed and encouraged to participate.
- Employees and immediate family members of the Town of Halton Hills may participate.

Contest Closing Information

The contest closes at 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 3rd.

All food donations must be collected and dropped off at either Georgetown Bread Basket (49B Mountainview Road North, Georgetown) or Acton Foodshare (352 Queen Street, Unit 6, Acton) by Saturday, October 3rd between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., where the food will be weighed and recorded.

How to Enter

1. Register your neighbourhood/street on the Town's website (www.haltonhills.ca/heyneighbour).
2. Collect non-perishable food donations from friends, family, neighbors, and community members. Make sure to visit the food bank's websites to see the most needed/requested items on their lists.

3. Neighbourhood/street organizers will deliver all collected food donations to either Acton Foodshare or Georgetown Breadbasket by Saturday, October 3rd between 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.
4. Ensure the food bank is aware that you are participating in the Town's Ultimate Neighbourhood Block Party Contest by filling in a form at the food bank, so the food bank volunteers can weigh the items your organizers have dropped off and record the weight on the tracking sheet at the food bank.
5. Donations must be clearly identified with your neighbourhood's name and contact organizer's name at the time of drop-off.

Accepted Donations

Only unopened, non-expired, non-perishable food items will be accepted. Items that are damaged, opened, expired, or otherwise unsuitable for distribution may not be counted toward the contest.

Although monetary donations are welcome, they will not be included for the purpose of this contest.

Winner Selection

The neighbourhood/street who collects the most weight of eligible food items during the contest period will be declared the winner. In the event of a tie, a random draw will occur.

Prize

The winning neighbourhood/street will receive an ULTIMATE neighbourhood block party experience on Saturday, October 17th (rain date Sunday, October 18th from 1:00 p.m. – 4:00 p.m. The prize is non-transferable and has no cash value. The Town of Halton Hills reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value, if necessary, or to move the prize to an indoor location should inclement weather be a concern.

Winner Notification

The winning neighbourhood/street will be notified by email on Tuesday, October 6th. If the winner cannot be reached within 2 days or is determined to be ineligible, an alternate winner may be selected.

General Conditions

- By participating, entrants agree to abide by these Official Rules and the decisions of the Town of Halton Hills, which are final.
- Participants are expected to collect donations in a respectful, lawful, and courteous manner. Any fraudulent activity or misrepresentation may result in disqualification.
- The Town of Halton Hills reserves the right to modify, suspend, or cancel the contest if circumstances beyond its reasonable control affect the administration or fairness of the contest.
- By accepting a prize, the winner grants The Town of Halton Hills permission to use their name and photograph for promotional purposes related to the contest, unless prohibited by law.

Privacy

Personal information collected through this contest will be used solely for the administration of the contest and the awarding of any prizes and will not be sold. Information will only be disclosed as necessary to administer the contest or as authorized or required by law.
