



## **NOTICE OF PUBLIC OPEN HOUSE**

### **STAND ALONE AGGREGATE RELATED USES STUDY**

**DATE/TIME:** Tuesday October 30, 2012, 6:30 P.M. to 8:00 P.M.

**LOCATION:** Town of Halton Hills Civic Centre, Council Chambers,  
1 Halton Hills Drive, Georgetown

The Town of Halton Hills has initiated a Stand Alone Aggregate Related Uses Study to review and clarify the land use planning framework, and associated zoning regulations, for mineral aggregate extraction related land uses (i.e. concrete batching plants, asphalt plants, and aggregate transfer stations) that are not associated with a mineral resource extraction operation licensed under the *Aggregate Resources Act*.

The purpose of the study is to examine land use compatibility issues associated with these land uses (including: noise, odour, air quality/dust, aesthetics and truck traffic), and to provide recommendations regarding the appropriate location, regulations and standards for these uses. Appropriate after uses and zoning for mined out aggregate extraction sites is also being examined.

An Open House is being held for the Stand Alone Aggregate Related Uses Study to present the project to the community and obtain input from the public and stakeholders on a Background and Policy Options Paper.

The purpose of the Open House is to:

- Introduce the project to the public and stakeholders.
- Present a Background and Policy Options Paper prepared by the consulting team which includes background research and identifies alternative policy options.
- Solicit public and stakeholder input on the findings of the Background and Policy Options Paper.

A presentation will be made by the consultant at 7:00 pm.
