

# NOTICE OF STATUTORY PUBLIC MEETING

## Cannabis Cultivation and Processing in Halton Hills

Monday, May 6, 2019, 7 p.m.

The Town of Halton Hills is currently undertaking a study on cannabis cultivation and processing. This study began in April of 2018 with research on policy and procedure related to medical cannabis production. With recreational cannabis legalization introduced under the Cannabis Act, the scope of the study changed to include all cannabis-related activities that would be governed under this legislation.

### More specifically, the purpose of this study is to:

- Provide policy options for introducing cannabis cultivation and processing into the Town's Official Plan and Zoning By-law;
- Establish a preferred policy option for Committee endorsement; and
- Develop Official Plan and Zoning By-law Amendments to regulate cannabis cultivation and processing in Halton Hills and seek Council approval for their passing.

### To date the study has achieved the following milestones:

- A background report, prepared by Meridian Planning Consultants, approved by Council on September 10, 2018;
- Online public engagement on the Let's Talk Halton Hills platform ([letstalkhaltonhills.ca/cannabis](http://letstalkhaltonhills.ca/cannabis)); and,
- A directions report outlining policy options, and recommending a preferred approach for Committee endorsement.

### The purpose of the Public Meeting is to:

- Provide background information on the study to date;
- Present results of the online public survey that was available from December 19, 2018 to January 16, 2019.
- Present the policy options outlined in the directions report; and
- Solicit public input on the preferred policy option for cannabis cultivation and processing in Halton Hills.
