

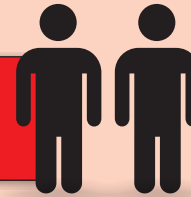
Swimming Admission Policy

STOP!

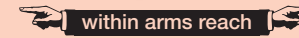
Children age 6 and under may not be admitted to the swimming pool unless they are accompanied by a guardian 14 years of age or older. The guardian is responsible for their direct supervision and must be in the water and able to assist immediately.

Maximum 2 children per guardian.

CAUTION

Children age 7-10 who are *non-swimmers* must be accompanied by a guardian, 14 years of age or older. The guardian is responsible for their direct supervision in the water and must be in the water and able to assist immediately. **Maximum 2 children per guardian.**

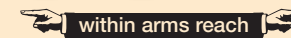
Children 7-10 may be admitted to the pool unsupervised only if they can pass the *facility swim test. Swimming with a buddy is strongly recommended.

Family Swim: all minors must be directly supervised by a guardian who 18+ years of age. Guardians must be in the water.

Children age 11 years or older may be admitted to the pool area unsupervised. Swimming with a buddy is strongly recommended.

Family Swim: all minors must be directly supervised by a guardian 18+ years of age. Guardians must be in the water.

***SWIM TESTING:** The facility swim test is a minimum of two widths of the swimming pool. Swimmers may also be required to tread water up to 1 minute. Individuals with serious medical conditions or developmental disabilities are at a greater risk while swimming. They should be accompanied at all times by another individual with knowledge of their condition who can render immediate assistance if needed.
